









with them. The discovery of one's identity will play the role of a tool for intercultural dialogue.

The **objectives** of "All about You" are:

- Provide youngsters with a higher awareness of themselves and their identity;
- Help the participants to discover the elements that build their identity and be able to explain them to the others;
- Develop participants' ability to identify, reflect and deal with cultural differences and increase their acceptance of differencies;
- Develop participants' video making and interviewing skills.



THE ACTIVITIES

All the sessions will be highly participatory, will be focused on the development of the participants and will be based on **non formal methods**, they will include: group works, individual and group reflections, team building activities, role plays, meditation session, interviews, video making, discussions activities, presentations, informal moments.

The practical **outcomes** of the project will be:

- an online handbook about identity, which will contain videos and written interviews that participants will do to locals;
- an infographic about the project topics.

After the youth exchange, each country group will take care of **dissemination** and promotional activities which will include: writing articles and online content, 3 presentations/workshops per country group.

Before the youth exchange, as part of the preparation, each national group should make a research about local realities on the topics of: migration, religion, cultural diversification, and will be asked to perform some tasks.

Be ready to present your culture to the others during the **intercultural evening**, through the use of interactive presentations, games, dances, traditional food and drinks.

Please bring anything you need to present your country at best!



The Youth exchange will involve 30 participants and group leaders coming from 6 different countries (4 participants + 1 g.l. per country): Italy, Cyprus, Spain, France, Poland and North Macedonia.

Participants: 18 - 25 years old, 4 per country. They will come from two target groups:


- youngsters coming from villages, rural or isolated areas that have a strong connection to their traditional culture;
- youngsters with a multicultural background.

All participants are interested in the topics of identity and self development, in meeting other cultures and widening their horizons.

Group leaders: 22 and 35 years old, 1 per country. They will be experienced members of their NGOs, with previous experience in international mobility projects. They must have a good knowledge of non formal education, positive attitude, leadership skills, empathy and problem solving skills.

Both participants and group leaders must be available to attend all the project phases: preparation, youth exchange in Italy and dissemination once back in their countries. 60% of the group will be at their first experience with international mobility projects. Partner organizations are encouraged to keep the gender balance as much as possible when creating the group of participants.

Participants with fewer opportunities will be fully involved in the project, they will receive additional support from their organisations.



THE VENUE

ACCOMMODATION

The youth exchange will take place in Quartu Sant'Elena, Sardinia, Italy. You will accommodated in multiple rooms with other participants from different countries.

The meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be provided on site and in nearby restaurants, so that you can experience Italian cousine.





WHAT TO BRING

Personal belongings, hygiene products and towels, swimsuit, any medicine you might need. At least two laptops per country, cameras and other tools you might need to record videos. Anything you need to present your country in the intercultural evening.





WEATHER



In october the temperature might range between 14° and 23°. Rain might be possible. Some activities will be done outside so please bring comfortable clothes, shoes and a rain jacket.



INSURANCE

Each participant MUST have a valid health insurance during their stay in Italy (health insurance will not be reimbursed by the organizers). Participants from the EU can use the European Health Insurance Card (E111 card).




HOW TO GET THERE
