





From Mont-Saint-Michel to Tréport, from Cherbourg to Alençon, Normandy offers a fantastic mosaic of landscapes.

THE LANDING AND THE BATTLE OF NRMANDY

In 1944, on the 6th of June and during the long summer that followed, men from all over the world came to fight in Normandy to bring down Nazism and restore Freedom.



ARROMANCHES

10 KM



In the heart of the D-Day beaches of June 1944, Arromanches owes its fame to the remains of the artificial port. The astonishing images of this unique place are as beautiful as they are disturbing.

CAEN, HEIR TO WILLIAM THE CONQUERER

- · Botanical Gardens: 2,000 rare plant species
- Meadow and racecourse: 90 hectares of greenery with an aviary
- Jardins des Simples: aromatic and medicinal plants and a vegetable garden in the medieval castle
- Banks of the Orne: 5 km of footpaths for walking
- Parc de la Colline aux oiseaux: 17 hectares of landscaped gardens (labyrinth, fountains, animal park, play areas and a rose garden with 570 varieties)
- Michel d'Ornano Park, French garden of the Abbaye aux Dames
- Mémorial Museum ...





ETRETAT AND ITS MAJESTIC CLIFFS

Étretat, a romantic setting overlooking the English Channel, has inspired the most illustrious artists. A few moments on the spot are enough to understand why... The singular shape of its cliffs, be it the Manneporte, the Courtine or the Aiguille, invites the imagination.



LE MONT-SAINT-MICHEL AND ITS BAY

Mont-Saint-Michel has the unique feature of being built on a rocky islet, surrounded by a magnificent bay, the location of the highest tides in continental Europe. The Mont and its bay are classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is one of the most visited monuments in France



GRANVILLE AND CHAUSEY IN MONT-SAINT-MICHEL'S BAY



Granville is built on a rocky promontory that closes the bay of Mont-Saint-Michel. It was in this setting that Christian Dior grew up, whose childhood home has become a museum. 15 km off the Pointe du Roc, Chausey is the island district of Granville.

As part of your project, you will be working in the Mayor's Office at Bayeux Town Hall.. Marine will be your supervisor and mentor.



For this project, the City Council is looking for **2** European volunteers.



Mission dates:

Arrival: 20th september 2023 or 18th october 2023

=> Work will be from Tuesday to Saturday

Duration: 10 months

The missions: Digital technology to raise awareness among the population, especially young people, about the theme of European citizenship.

The volunteers will work during their placement on

- Participation in the organization of major events in 2024:
 - Commemoration of the 80th anniversary of the Normandy landings
 - Events around the 2024 Olympic Games in connection with sports services
- Organization from A to Z of an organized trip to a European country
- Organisation of a " European week " In Bayeux in May 2024 in close cooperation with the different departments and associations of the town.
- Work on the preparation and dissemination of a support for the general public on knowledge of the history of the European Union
- Intervene in schools (middle schools and high schools) to talk about your country and your culture, and doing activities with the children of the day care centre with the youth workers (children from 3 to 15 years old)
- Meetings in community and social centres to discover cultures (cooking, traditions workshops...)
- Involvement in the projects of twinned committees (cities in Norway, Netherlands, Germany, England, Poland, Ireland)
- Creation of photo and video reports and manage a social network about your stay
- Develop the #BayeuxForEurope project by going out to meet the population to talk about Europe

Accomodation

TRANSPORTS

The easiest way to get to Bayeux (by landing in Paris) is by train. You will have to go to Paris Saint Lazare station, then you will take the train Paris-Cherbourg. You will get off at the Bayeux train station.

Bayeux is close to Paris (about 2 hours by train). It is best to buy tickets online (www.oui.sncf) and print them in advance.

There are also direct buses from the airport to Caen, a town 20 minutes from Bayeux (https://fr.ouibus.com/destinations).

If you land at Beauvais airport, there is a shuttle bus to Paris.

There are also shuttle buses from every airport in Paris to the train stations.

For transport between Bayeux and other towns in the department or neighbouring department, there is a rail network (SNCF) and a bus network (Bus Vert). The nearest major town is Caen (25 km from Bayeux).

Pocket Money



At the beginning of each month, the volunteer will receive both grocery money (210€) and some pocket money (180€) for personal use.

All travel expenses to Bayeux will be reimbursed according to the mileage, and the city of departure, with a maximum amount.



All travel expenses will be reimbursed on a mileage basis, up to a maximum of €275.

Any costs above this amount must be covered by the volunteer.

The City of Bayeux will cover travel for business purposes. No visa required

Weather

The climate in Normandy is sometimes rainy, cold in winter and moderate in summer. The volunteer can bring sportswear and swimwear.



It is not necessary to bring bedding.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a Hosting Organisation? This is the organisation that will host you, i.e. the Bayeux Town Hall. They welcome the volunteer in their work assignment and provide mentoring, daily life etc.

What is a Sending Organisation? This is the organisation in your country of origin that will deploy the volunteer - their role is to prepare the volunteer, to be in contact with them during the mission, to listen to them and to support them in their work.
