




DESCRIPTION AND AIMS OF THE PROJECT

23 July





ACCOMMODATION:

- In TENTS (with matrasses on the floor)
- And SHARED ROOMS (double beds and rooms of 6 -8 people)
- The accommodation is shared with long term volunteers

You will eat with catering and cook the food yourself together with other people

WHAT DO WE EXPECT FROM THE PARTICIPANTS?

- Not flexible, nor cooperative people.
- Lack of interest and engagement.
- People coming for "holidays".
- The use of alcohol and drugs is not allowed during the camp.
- Do not bring your entire wardrobe, take only the necessary clothes.
- Demanding people.

- Open-minded participants interested in the environment.
- Ready to work, collaborate, and create something new together.
- Active young people who want to learn new skills and develop.
- Positive people willing to broaden their perspectives, share their culture, and acquire new knowledge.
- Prepare yourself before your arrival date and attend all meetings and activities related to the project.



WHAT TO BRING?

PERSONAL CARE

- Cap to cover from the sun.
- Sheets or sleeping bag and pillow.
- Bathing suit, flip-flop, towel, sunscreen, anti-mosquito cream.
- Personal items you need.

PERSONAL STUFF

Bring your **re-usable**:

- dish
- glass
- cutlery
- and Bottle to fill with water.

Attention: don't bring all your wardrobe but remember to bring some dark clothes...(they always help in case of performance).

DOCUMENTS

- European Sanitary Card (EU) or private medical insurance (non-EU). People with **no** insurance won't be accepted.
- All participants: Social responsibility insurance for travelling (Insurance with repatriation clause)
- Personal medication (in case you need it).
- Required documents, send scanned (image permission, document of responsibility, sanitary card and ID/passport).

WHAT TO BRING?

PREPARE YOURSELF AS A GROUP BEFORE COMING

- **Intercultural presentation:** as a group, you have to prepare an intercultural presentation about your territory, from your country...You can bring **music**, some **food**, pictures, traditional dresses...be original and DO NOT USE REGULAR PRESENTATIONS
- Prepare **4 energizers per country** (max 15 minutes each). You need to write them on **Google Drive**.
- **Workshop on environmental topics** (about 1,30h): Each country will work on a topic that will be agreed upon in the previous online meeting.

From **Barcelona's airport** "Aeroport el Prat" **T1** to **T2** you need to take the **shuttle bus**




