WHERE?

Latvia is a country in the Baltic region of Northern Europe. It is one of the Baltic states and is bordered by Estonia, Lithuania, Russia, Belarus, and shares a maritime border with Sweden.

Latvia covers an area of 64,589 km², with a population of 1.9 million. The country has a temperate seasonal climate. Its capital and largest city is Riga, the official spoken language is Latvian but Russian and English are both widely used.

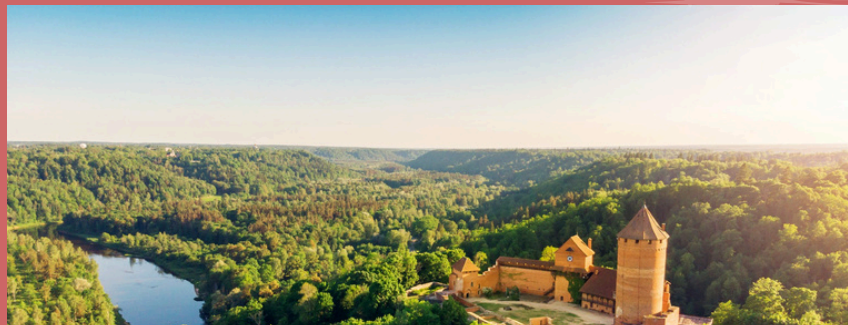

WHAT IS AFS?



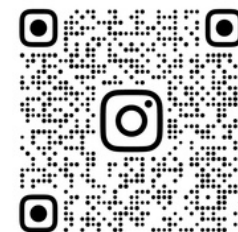

(3) POSITIONS: AFS LATVIA

- 1. The First volunteer will work with social media and digital design with the goal of sharing the AFS mission – planning and preparing contents for the AFS Latvia official instagram account (IG takeovers, taking care of the stories, preparing posts etc..), planning and taking care of the official AFS Latvia tiktok account (making videos, editing, thinking of new content, following the trends etc..) organizing and recording podcasts for the official AFS Latvia podcast which is now located on AFS.lv website. The volunteer is also expected to participate in regular AFS hosting and sending camps as a trainer and facilitator.**
- 2. The Second volunteer will be responsible of cooperating with Latvian schools, therefore of facilitating school presentations on its own and with the help of AFS volunteers and exchange students. The volunteer will also be responsible of cooperating with Youth Centers and thinking of extra-curriculum school activities to engage the Latvian youth with the AFS community (for example by planning intercultural events). The volunteer will also attend regular AFS camps and organize different activities for volunteers, such as ICL, the national T4T, intercultural events with exchange students etc... Another task of the volunteer is to plan activities for the exchange students so that they are able to be involved in AFS even though they live outside of Riga.**
- 3. The Third volunteer will have to Coordinate the production of social media content, assist in planning and organizing events, to go to schools and invite youth to volunteer and advertise social activity, to go to schools and invite people to participate in youth politics of the city, to go to Universities and organize open days for young people, participate in training sessions and workshops to enhance skills, work closely with other volunteers and staff members to achieve common goal.**

ACCOMODATION AND MONTHLY BUDGET

Each volunteer will be provided with a single room in a shared apartment in the city in which they will volunteer. Accomodation is covered by the project.

Each volunteer will be also provided with a monthly budget of 375€ for living expenses (pocket money, food and personal expences)



HOLIDAYS

Most of the weekends are free. If there is an important project during the weekend, the volunteer will know in advance and will get extra free days in the following weeks.

Bank holidays are free: Christmas, Easter, Misummer (23/24th June), 18th November, 1st May, 4th May.

Every month, the volunteer gathers 2 free days for their vacation.
