BENEFITS

According to the European Solidarity Corps programme, the project covers all costs related to:

- Travel from your home country (back and forth)
- Accomodation
- Food and pocket money (monthly allowance)
- Public transport
- Health insurance (provided by Cigna insurance)

You will get:

- An electric bike
- A free access to the Online Language Support platform

You will have the opportunity to develop your own project related to your personal interests.



You will be hosted in a **studio** on the center of Lisieux.

The room (studio) will be furnished, has a bathroom and kitchen and has access to a wi-fi

connection.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION



At the end of each month, the volunteers will receive both money for the groceries and pocket money for their personal use (480€ in total). If you need it at the start of your voluntary service, you will be accompanied to a local bank (Crédit Agricole Normandie) to open a French account in which you will receive your money each month.



The **travel costs** are going to be **reimbursed**. Any costs exceeding that amount will be covered by the volunteer.

The most important facts about reimbursement:

- always **ask** before you buy the tickets
- **keep** the original receipts
- bring all the papers back to Le Lab



Lisieux Normandie Agglo will **not** provide you with a french SIM card or phone. If you think that you would profit from a french contract during your voluntary service you will have to take necessary measures yourself.



NORMANDIE



Normandie has several places and traditions listed as **UNESCO World Heritage sites**, as well as villages listed among the "Most Beautiful Villages of France" and spas. In addition to these remarkable sites, and many beautiful detours, each town and village in Normandie is worth discovering!

From Mont-Saint-Michel to Tréport, from Cherbourg to Alençon, Normandie offers a fantastic mosaic of landscapes.

LISIEUX

Lisieux is a town with 20.000 inhabitants.

It is located just **2 hours by train from Paris**! It is 50 km away from **Caen** (20 min by train), 73 km away from **Rouen** (45 min by train), and 29 km from **Deauville-Trouville** (20 min by train).

It has a magnificent **basilic** who resisted the bombs of the Second World War (we have a lot of history!)







LANDING/BATTLE

In 1944, on the 6th of June and during the long summer that followed, men from all over the world came to fight in Normandie to bring down Nazism and restore Freedom.





Deauville With its casino, palaces, listed villas, racecourses, marinas, convention centre, American Film Festival, golf courses and nightclubs, it is considered to be one of the most prestigious seaside resorts in France.

Trouville Considered as Deauville's twin, Trouville is one of the oldest seaside resort of Normandy. The years have passed and the town has grown, but it has managed to retain its soul as a small fishing port and still charms visitors.

MONT-SAINT-MICHEL



Mont-Saint-Michel has the unique feature of being built on a rocky islet, surrounded by a magnificent bay, the location of the highest tides in continental Europe. The Mont and its bay are classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

ROUEN

Rouen, capital of Normandie, a region in the north of France, is a port city on the River Seine. An important city in Roman times and in the Middle Ages, it boasts Gothic churches such as Saint-Maclou and Saint-Ouen. The skyline is dominated by the spires of Notre-Dame Cathedral, often depicted by Impressionist painter Claude Monet.
