What is REFORE NETWORK?

REFORE NETWORK (Youth Network for Recovering the Forgotten Remembrance) is a European project funded by the CERV Programme.

It brings together young activists and organisations from Portugal, Spain, France and Italy to:

- Recover and value European Remembrance of totalitarian regimes and resistance.
- Create a youth activist base group in each country, open and diverse, working on research, education and campaigns.
- Promote human rights and democratic values through local actions, international mobilities, podcasts and itineraries.
- Give visibility to forgotten voices, especially women and exiled people.

Together we aim to build a Europe that remembers the past to defend democracy today.



Why this meeting?

(Objectives of the Lisbon activity)

- Make known at a European level key spaces linked to the Salazar Dictatorship in Portugal.
- Reflect together on democracy, human rights and EU fundamental rights through the lens of Portuguese history.
- Co-create outputs: contributions to local itineraries, campaign ideas, and podcast themes connected to Portugal's memory sites.
- Strengthen the youth activists' network: teamwork, peer learning and planning next steps.

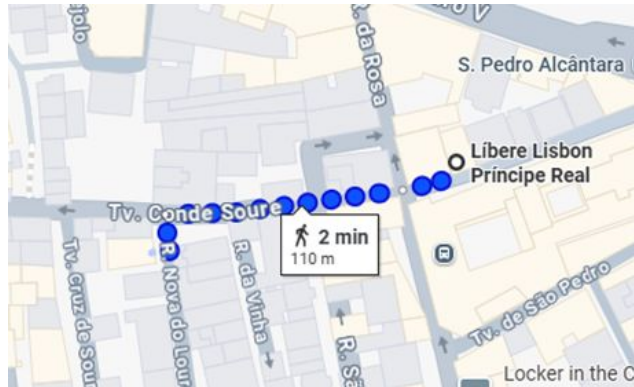
Practical Information

Accommodation

How to get from the airport

By Metro:

- Option 1: **Red Line** → São Sebastião → **Blue Line** → Restauradores → walk 850m (uphill)
 - Option 2: **Red Line** → Saldanha → **Yellow Line** → Rato → walk 1km
- Ticket: €1,85 + €0,50 card

By Taxi/Uber/Bolt:

- Around €11–15 (+ €2 per bag)
Be aware of scams: always ask for a receipt and note car/plate if the price seems off.
- **Meals:** Breakfast at accommodation; group lunches/dinners when scheduled; some **free-time meals** for participants to explore Lisbon's food culture.
- We'll mostly use **public transport** and walk between sites. Bring **comfortable shoes**.



Travel & Reimbursement (how it works)

Who reimburses?

- **Auryn** will manage reimbursements with partner orgs. (280/person)

What is reimbursed?

- **Economy travel** to/from Lisbon on activity travel days (and local transfers when foreseen).

What you must provide:

1. **Original invoices/receipts** showing amount paid & name
2. **Tickets/boarding passes** (both ways)
3. If needed, **payment proof**

Tip: *book early, keep **all originals**, and photograph everything as backup.*



What to bring

- **ID/Passport, EHIC** (or insurance), personal meds
- **Comfortable clothing & walking shoes**
- **Light rain jacket/umbrella** (weather can change)
- **Reusable bottle**, notebook/pen
- **Respectful mindset** for visits to memory sites
