Il Paguro is a youth hospitality and aggregation centre in Casapesenna (Caserta). The property was confiscated from organised crime and granted to A.P.S Giosef Italy - Giovani Senza Frontiere by Agrorinasce Scarl. The latter entity permitted the property to be transformed into a "Centre for the Promotion of Social Engagement and Playroom." The property's renovation was made possible by a grant from the Ministry of Internal Affairs - PON Sicurezza.

The hostel has an inclusive and multipurpose space with the capacity to accommodate up to 28 individuals and is equipped with all essential and ancillary services. The centre facilitates the implementation of intercultural exchange youth programmes, training courses, active citizenship actions, national and international internships, city twinning, conventions and meetings. All of the aforementioned projects are characterised by a focus on research, innovation, solidarity, cooperation and social development.

Casapesenna is a small town in the province of Caserta, situated in the Campania region of southern Italy. Located approximately 30 kilometres north of Naples, Casapesenna is nestled in a region known for its historical significance and agricultural landscapes. The town is part of the wider Caserta area, which is famous for its rich cultural heritage and proximity to significant historical sites.

Despite its small size, Casapesenna's proximity to major cultural and historical sites in Campania makes it a strategic base for exploring southern Italy. 


NUOVA CUCINA ORGANIZZATA (NCO)

REQUIREMENTS



BE BETWEEN 18 AND 30 YEARS OLD.

ITALIAN KNOWLEDGE IS A PLUS! BUT NOT MANDATORY

BE OPEN-MINDED, ADAPTABLE, AND WILLING TO ENGAGE WITH THE COMMUNITIES.

INTEREST IN WORKING WITH KIDS AND YOUNG PEOPLE

BE A PERSON WHO KNOWS HOW TO WORK ON A TEAM AND SHARED LIVING

HAVE A WORKING KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH (ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE SKILLS ARE A PLUS).

BUDGETING

The expected commitment is **35 hours per week**.

Sundays and Italian holidays will be free for the volunteers and in case of more activities scheduled for the weekend, the free days will have space in the following week.

Adding to this, every month there will be **2 additional days of mid-week rest** that the volunteers can manage their placement.

An expert mentor, coordinator and supervisor will follow the volunteering period.

PAGURO

Giosef Italy will host the volunteers in their facility, **The Paguro**. Where they will have all the commodities and the organization will cover the costs for utilities (electricity, water, gas).



TRAVELS

Travel expenses are **covered by European Solidarity Corps**, being **reimbursed** after the volunteer travels.



POCKET & FOOD MONEY

VOLUNTEERS WILL ALSO RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE, WHICH IS SUFFICIENT TO COVER DAILY EXPENSES (FOOD, PERSONAL EXPENSES, ETC.).

ACCOMODATION



You'll receive complimentary accommodation at our Youth Hostel and centre.

Volunteers will share communal living spaces, sleeping in shared rooms that include individual beds and storage options like closets and/or lockers. Bathrooms are also shared, with designated areas for personal belongings.



The kitchen is fully equipped with all the necessary cooking utensils. The hostel also features a spacious living room filled with various games, along with a dedicated workspace that provides a peaceful environment for volunteers to focus on their tasks or engage in activities, including sports.



Our garden, which boasts a majestic olive tree, and a large lemon tree, serves as a tranquil oasis where volunteers can sip homemade lemonade and watch the local cats enjoying the beautiful surroundings.

FROM AIRPORT TO HOME



From Fiumicino

(1) First, get to Rome Termini train station:

By bus: Outside the arrivals terminal at Fiumicino, use the temporary shuttle service (due to construction); the ticket costs about €5, and the journey takes approximately 50 minutes (travel time may be slightly longer because of detours caused by the works).

(2) From Roma Termini, take the train to Albanova:

Ticket: around €12

Travel time: 2-3 hours

Trains run regularly, but the last train leaves at 20:50. To allow time for any delays and the shuttle back to FCO, you should plan to be back at the airport no later than 18:00.

From Ciampino

(1) Get to Rome Termini train station:

By bus: Outside the arrivals terminal at Ciampino, take a replacement shuttle service to Roma Termini. The ticket costs about €5, and the journey takes approximately 45 minutes (please note that travel time might be slightly longer due to traffic and ongoing works).

(2) Once at Roma Termini, take a train to Albanova:

Ticket: around €12

Travel time: 2-3 hours

Trains are quite frequent, but the last one departs at 20:50. Therefore, to be safe, you should plan to arrive at Ciampino Airport (CIA) by 18:00 at the latest.

From Naples

(1) From Naples, get to Albanova Train station:

- You can take a train from Naples Centrale to Albanova train station (travel time varies from approximately 30 minutes to 45 minutes, depending on the train type and detours caused by construction). Always check updated schedules before you travel.

- Trains run regularly, but the last train leaves at 20:50.
