Who?

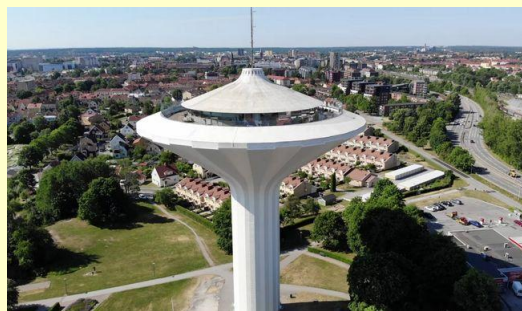
6 motivated volunteers age 18-30. The call is open to EU-citizens + Ukrainian, Norwegian and Icelandic citizens.
