


Where?




Accommodations



THE CLOSEST AIRPORT IS 'AEROPORTO G. MARCONI **BOLOGNA** BLQ', L'AEROPORTO DI **FORLÌ** (IATA: FRL, ICAO: LIPK) OR AEROPORTO INTERNAZIONALE "FEDERICO FELLINI **RIMINI**.

Volunteer Schedule:


- Activities take place from Monday to Friday.
- You'll be contributing your time and skills for around 30 to 35 hours per week.

Time Off:

- Weekends are generally free.
- **Bank holidays**, such as Christmas, are also designated as **free** days to enjoy as you like.

Additional Time Off:

- Every month, you'll have the chance to enjoy 2 extra days off, which adds up to a total of 12 days off during period of 6 months.



Weather

SPRING (MARCH TO MAY):

SPRING IN EMILIA-ROMAGNA IS PLEASANTLY MILD. EXPECT TEMPERATURES RANGING FROM 10°C TO 25°C. RAINFALL IS MODERATE, SO PACK AN UMBRELLA AND LAYERS FOR COOL MORNINGS AND EVENINGS.

SUMMER (JUNE TO AUGUST):

SUMMERS ARE WARM AND DRY WITH TEMPERATURES AVERAGING 25°C TO 40°C. SUNSCREEN, SUNGLASSES, AND LIGHTWEIGHT CLOTHING ARE ESSENTIAL.

AUTUMN (SEPTEMBER TO NOVEMBER): AUTUMN IS COMFORTABLE, WITH TEMPERATURES RANGING FROM 15°C TO 30°C . IT'S A GREAT TIME FOR OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES. PACK LAYERS AND A LIGHT JACKET FOR COOLER EVENINGS.

WINTER (DECEMBER TO FEBRUARY): WINTERS ARE COOLER, WITH TEMPERATURES BETWEEN 0°C AND 10°C). OCCASIONAL RAINFALL OCCURS, SO BRING A WARM COAT, SWEATERS, AND WATERPROOF GEAR.

What to pack

Clothing: Pack a variety of clothing, including lightweight summer wear, comfortable spring and autumn attire, and warm winter clothing

Adapters: typically uses Type C and Type F electrical outlets

Footwear:

Comfortable walking shoes are a must, especially for exploring the local area.

Sun Protection: Don't forget sunscreen, sunglasses, and a wide-brimmed hat for the summer days

Umbrella or Rain

Gear: Be prepared for occasional rain, so bring an umbrella or raincoat.

Reusable Water

Bottle: Stay hydrated and reduce plastic waste by carrying a reusable water bottle.
