- **Living in an international community:** sharing daily life and experiences with peers from different countries.
- **Teamwork:** collaborating with peers from different countries and learning from each other.



ABOUT THE PROGRAM OF YEs:

The program of each YE includes **two main intensive workshop sessions**, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

The agenda will not include a visit to the surrounding neighbouring cities.

ACCOMMODATION

LA BUONA TERRA is located in a beautiful country farm in the middle of a centuries-old olive grove in Passignano sul Trasimeno, a small town on Lake Trasimeno, in Umbria, Italy.

The place that hosts La Buona Terra was built in 1821 and has functioned as the first educational farm in Italy for the past 30 years.

The group of participants will be accommodated in tents, similar to **glamping tents**, with 8 places each and assigned by gender. The venue is equipped with toilets in the camping area and bathrooms in the house.

Activities and practical workshops will be hosted mainly in the multi-purpose hall and outdoor space. The facility includes a **professional kitchen and dining room**. Meals will be prepared and served by our kitchen staff.

Please note that there is **no available washing machine** in the venue, therefore plan ahead the appropriate amount of clothes that you will need.

The venue is managed by following **sustainable practices** (such as garbage recycling, responsible water and electricity use, etc.) and **participants will be invited to follow these ones**.

Participants will be involved in the **daily maintenance tasks**: cleaning of the common spaces and support in the kitchen management (cleaning dishes, setting the tables, etc.)

Due to the sometimes unpredictable **water shortage in Italy**, some water cuts may occur in the hosting facilities. In case of water cut, the use of the water in the hosting structure (for showers, toilets) could be rearranged. For the whole duration of the project, drinkable water will always be guaranteed!

FOOD AND LODGEMENT COSTS for all the actions

Covered by the coordinating organization at 100%.



FINANCIAL CONDITION

The refund of the travel costs is only possible if participants travel from and return to the country of their sending organisation.

In order to be as sustainable as possible, Lunaria invites participants to choose the **greenest travel option** possible (e.g. carpooling, train, bus). Please, check the budget available in the table below.

Participants' travel costs will be refunded only upon the **presentation of all the original travel documents (paper and online)**.

Normally the refund process can take, approximately, **4-6 months**.

The travel costs are refunded according to the Travel Distance Calculator of the EACEA (table below):

FOR THE OFFICIAL ARRIVAL DAY

Meeting point in PASSIGNANO SUL TRASIMENO Train station:
on the **22nd of August** between **4:00 – 7:00 PM** CET (Central European Time).

FOR THE OFFICIAL DEPARTURE DAY

Drop off is planned on the **31st of August** between **7:00 – 8:00 AM** CET (Central European Time).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Only the participants who choose the Green Travel option have 4 days of flexibility (arrival and departure days not included) to travel to the venue. They can manage in the most suitable way for them (e.g. 2 extra days before the official arrival + 2 extra days after the official departure day; 1 extra day before the arrival, 3 extra days after the departure day). Hostel costs can be reimbursed during a stopover, but only in case of Green Travel and within the travel budget.

INSURANCE

Lunaria provides insurance during the project period for civil liability (only for possible accidents in project activities or those caused by participants).

Participants are strongly recommended to bring their own Health Insurance Card if they have one and to take travel insurance.

However, participants are not insured for personal belongings, and neither the host nor Lunaria can be held responsible for these during the project.
