



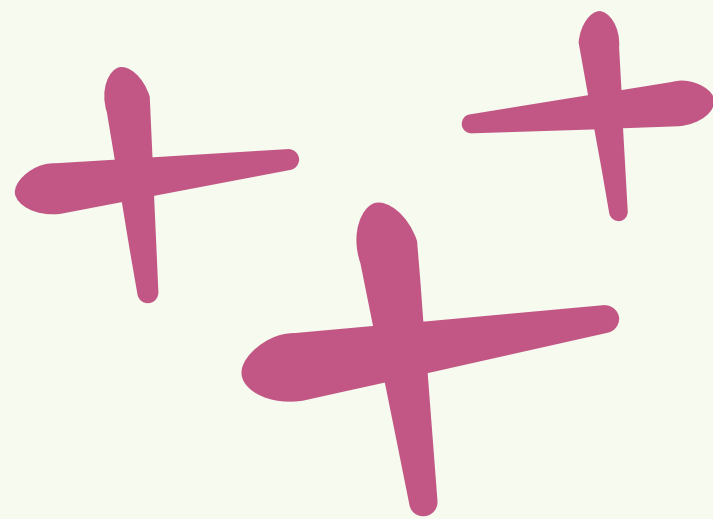

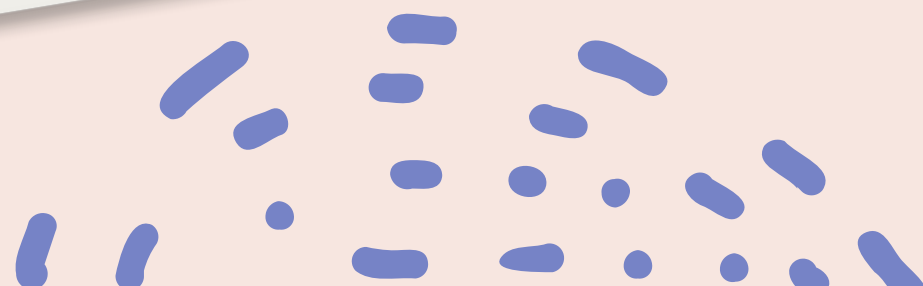
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WHO ARE WE?



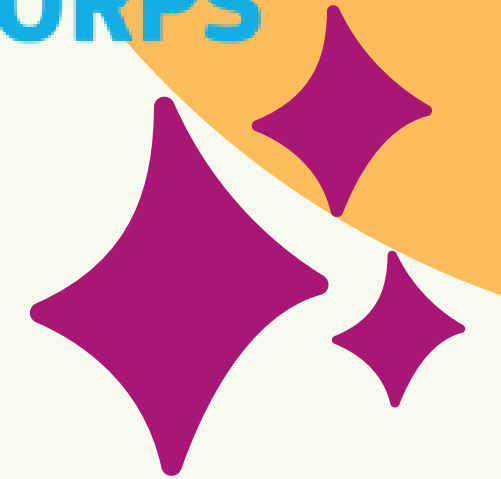

Organizing inclusive events and partnerships that foster dialogue, reduce stereotypes, and strengthen community cooperation.



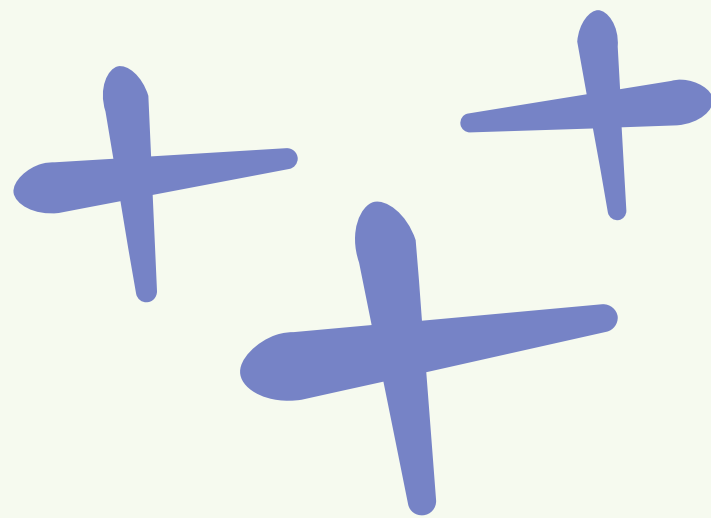

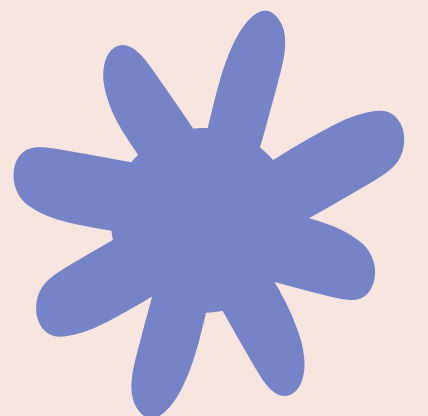


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There will be a few trainings that will take place.

1. On-arrival training: usually online, happens at the beginning of the project with ESC volunteers from the country. This is handled by the National Agency.
2. Internal training on working with children, teamwork and conflict resolution.
3. Mid-term training: Happens around the middle of the project, usually in-person with other ESC volunteers from the country. Handled by the National Agency.

In the beginning we will also have a Teambuilding to help break the ice and get to know each other.

Volunteers will live together in apartments, with each bedroom being shared by two people. Bathroom and kitchen will be shared by all apartment members.

LOCATION

Reșița is a mountain town with a population of approximately 58,000, located in the southwestern part of Romania. Three centuries ago, the first furnace was established in the city, marking the beginning of Reșița's development into a major industrial center, a status it maintains to this day. Situated in the heart of the Banat Mountains, Reșița offers residents the unique experience of living amidst lush greenery and mountainous landscapes, all while enjoying the conveniences of urban life.

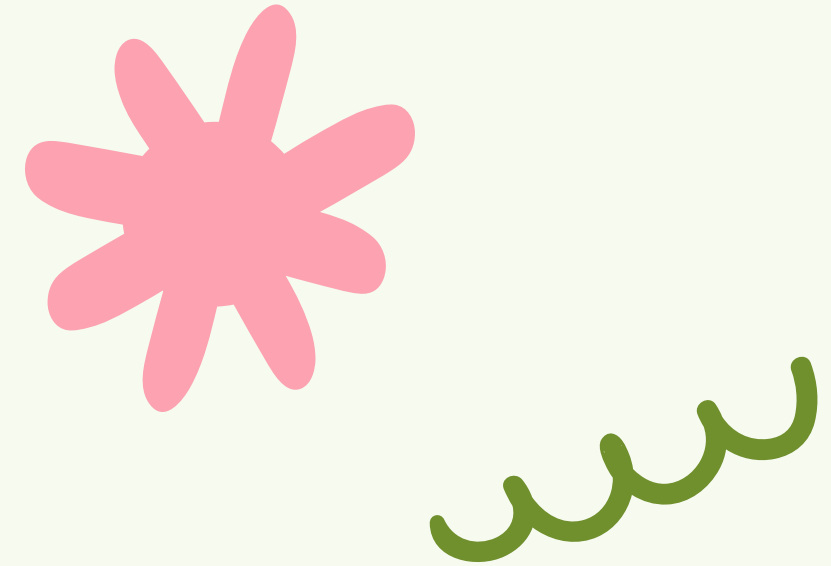




ARRIVAL



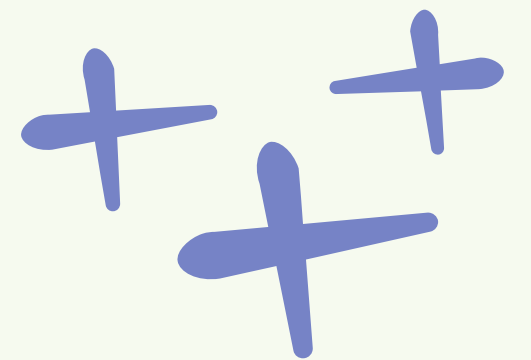
The project dates are flexible, but volunteers are expected to arrive **mid-September (around 10-15.09)**. Please note that arrival should be no later than the end of September.



The closest airport to Reșița is Timișoara International Airport.

If flights to Timișoara are not available, alternative airports include Budapest (Hungary), Belgrade (Serbia), or Bucharest (Romania).

From any of these cities, you can continue your journey to Reșița/Timișoara by train or bus connections.





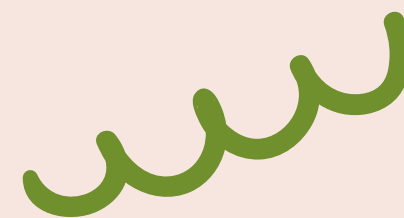

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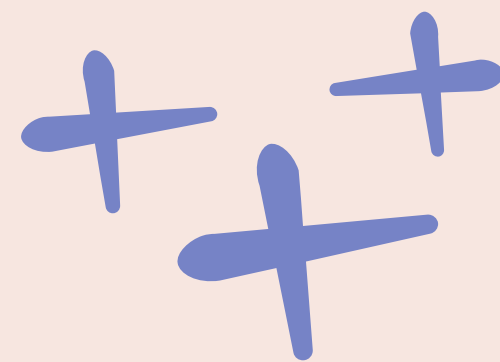


From Timișoara, you can reach the venue by first taking the E4B bus from the airport to Timișoara Nord Train Station. From Timișoara Nord, take a train to Reșița Nord.



Tickets can be bought on the train (cash only in Romanian currency) or in advance online [here](#), where you can also check schedules.

Once you arrive in Reșița we will pick you up from the train station and take you to the apartment.
